II. ELIGIBILITY:

Age: Not more than 50 years as on 01.01.2024

(Usual relaxation in upper age limit is admissible to candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC communities as per KS&SSR.)

Qualifications: As per UGC Regulations 2018.

III. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 1.The appointments in the above vacancies shall be made as per UGC Regulation 2018 and observing reservation principles in accordance with the Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University Statutes 2014 and its amendments, Kerala State & Subordinate Service Rules and Kerala Service Rules.
- a) In the Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, for all the teachers, viz. Assistant Professor, basic Veterinary Degree recognized by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI) and listed in the schedule of Indian Veterinary Council Act (Central Act 52 of 1984) is essential. However, in disciplines like Biotechnology, Biostatistics persons without basic Veterinary Degree can be considered only in the absence of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry Degree holders.
- b) In the faculty of Dairy Science and Technology, for all the teachers, viz., Assistant Professor, basic Degree in Dairy Science/ Technology or related Engineering is essential. However, in disciplines like Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Biostatistics, Dairy Husbandry and Computer Application, persons without basic Degree, in Dairy Science and Technology or related Engineering can be considered only in the absence of B.Tech., Dairy Science Degree holders.
- c) Knowledge in Malayalam is mandatory.
- 2. Applicants for the post under community reservation quota should submit Caste Certificate/Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued on or after 01.06.2024. Candidates who claim reservation under EWS category should produce relevant certificate/ documents issued by the competent Revenue Authority along with the application. Candidates who claim reservation under Person with benchmark disability are required to furnish Disability Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in proof of their Disability
- 3. Natives of States other than Kerala are not eligible to claim appointment under reservation quota.
- 4.Applications in the prescribed format duly filled in along with a copy of the Curriculum Vitae, self-attested copies of all the testimonials required as per eligibility criteria in a sealed envelope bearing the superscript: "Application for appointment to the post of

Assistant Professor......." (Here write the name of the discipline applying for and specify the Notification No also) and the full address of the applicant with the contact number should reach to the address "The Registrar,Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Pookode, Lakkidi P.O,Wayanad-673576,Kerala' on or before.03.02.2025,5.PM. Application fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rs 750/- in the case of applicants belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe /Persons with benchmark disabilities (PwBD) by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Finance Officer, KVASU, Pookode" payable at State Bank of India,Kalpetta Branch, Wayanad District, Kerala, shall also be enclosed with the application. Application format and scorecard can be downloaded from the University website (www.kvasu.ac.in)

- 5.Applicants working in Universities/ Government/Aided Colleges etc., shall submit No Objection Certificate from their employer along with the hard copy of the application.
- 6.Late and Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
- 7. The applications submitted will be the final and applicants are not permitted to add with additional document thereafter.
- 8.Updates on the recruitment will be available in the website of Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University **www.kvasu.ac.in.** The decisions of the University in all matters related to recruitment against this notification shall be final.
- 9. Selected Candidates for appointment, are liable to serve in any of the Colleges/Stations under the University as per the terms prescribed by the University.
- 10.Merit based rank list for each Department will be published and the vacancies will be filled from the Rank list. Rank list published will have validity for a maximum period of 3 years from the date of notification. However no appointments in excess of the vacancies notified above will be made against this notification.
