 - sciences and Animal Production Sciences, permission may be given to select Minor Courses from outside the list mentioned, if needed, as decided by the advisory committee.
 - iv. In Veterinary Clinical subject- Animal Reproduction, Gynaecology &Obstetrics- No clinical departments are enlisted among Minor Courses for M.V.Sc and PhD. Degree

- admission has started, the University has decided to implement the ICAR approved regulations and syllabi with the following modifications.
- 1) Minor subjects should be taken as mentioned in ICAR approved syllabus. For this, the students who have registered for 3rd semester should be given a chance for reregistering the courses as stipulated in newly approved ICAR syllabus. Also the students may be given a provision for changing the major, minor and supporting courses so as to comply with the **ICAR BSMA** regulations and syllabi 2021.
- 2) For Doctoral programme in Veterinary Medicine, Doctoral Research, is to be included as VMD 699 with 75 credits.
